Packing

Now, don't misunderstand what is being said here. Even though you have a [visa for Vietnam](#), that lasts a few years, this does not mean that you can stay in the country for that long.

For most countries that give you a visa that lasts for a year, you are allowed to stay in the country for 3 months and they will stamp your visa or your passport when you

are going through customs. This stamp will have the date that you need to leave the country by. You must abide by this rule otherwise you could be deported and you might not be allowed back in the country.
